STEWARDSHIP Questions & Answers

What is Stewardship?

Stewardship is a simple, equitable and Christian way by which every adult parishioner (family or individual) determines the amount he or she shall commit for the support of the Church, proportionate to his or her income. It's how we support and sustain the mission of the Church!

Why have a Stewardship Program?

Such a program eliminates inequities and places the responsibility of Church support where it belongs – in the hands of each parishioner. It is the one way that views the support of the church as a matter of personal commitment and conscience. It is the way taking financial responsibility for our church with Christian concern, dignity and equity. The emphasis is on equal sacrifice, not equal giving. We give according to our means.

Who is included in my commitment?

A pledging family (i.e. stewardship unit) includes husband, wife, and children under 18 years of age, or attending college and not self-supporting.

What about single adults?

Each working, self-supporting adult over 18 years of age should make his or her own commitment. To the parish in which they attend on a regular basis.

Who determines the level of offering?

The chart below provided suggested levels of giving based on annual income levels. These are suggested levels. We hope that our Mother, the Church, merits sacrificial giving and our best gifts.

Is there a minimum amount required?

There is no mandatory minimum. However, in order for us to have a functional budget, we encourage everyone to set an honest and fair portion of one's income for the ministries and support of the Church.

How do I become a steward?

By simply filling out the enclosed pledge form and either mailing it or bringing it to the Church office.

When should I fulfill my pledge?

Stewardship occurs on a calendar year basis. Parishioners are asked to fulfill their pledges by December 31 of the year in which they are pledging. Payments toward a pledge can be made on a monthly, quarterly, semi-annual or annual basis.

Will my pledge remain confidential?

Yes. Stewardship information kept in the strictest confidence. Only the names of all pledged stewards will be published in our bulletin and newsletter.

What if I need to revise my commitment?

You can change your pledge according to your changing financial situation by advising our priest of parish council treasurer. Again, this is always kept in strict confidence.

SUGGESTED LEVELS OF OFFERING

The following table offers suggested levels of giving based on combined household income. Think about it – the average financial pledge through the Greek Orthodox Archdiocese of America is roughly 218.00/yr. Considering the needs of the Church, and the biblical standard of tithing, which is 10% of our time, talent, and treasure, where does our own giving fit into the picture?

It's always wise to give in a manner that suites your needs (i.e. weekly, monthly, annually). However, first and foremost, we should always give in a manner that suites the needs of Christ and His Church!
